Product Data

A two pack, polyurethane primer surfacer, for use under PPG Industries' polyurethane wood finishes.

- Good sanding and filling properties
- Very fast drying
- High solids
- Very good holdout

Uses

Recommended as a primer surfacer on various wood based substrates.

Spray apply 110-165 microns Wet Film Thickness, to achieve 50-75 microns Dry Film Thickness.

Overcoat time is 6-24 hours, with sanding (360 grit).

Overcoat with 777HS, 269, 579, 555, 573, 575, 576.

White, Black

Packaging

570P – 4L, 20L 570B Hardener – 1L, 4L 178B/570BS Hardener – 1L

Substrate & Surface Preparation

Wood - Sand and dust down.

MDF – Sand faces with 150 grit, edges with 120 grit followed by 180 grit in the opposite direction.

Melamine/Laminate - Sand 180-240 grit. Dust down.

Mixing Ratio

Mix 4L 570P with 1L 570B Hardener (normal/cool conditions)

Mix 4L 570P with 1L 178B/570BS Hardener (warmer conditions)

Pot Life

With 570B: Once catalysed, pot life is up to 2 hours (@20C). This can be increased by 1 hour with additional thinning of 10% 140 reducer after 1 hour.

With 178B/570BS: Once catalysed, pot life is up to 6 hours (@20C).

Thinning and Clean Up

Thin 10-30 % with 140 Ester Thinner.

Clean gun and equipment with 140 Ester Thinner.

Application

Spray – conventional, airless.

Drying

Rapid drying and can be sanded after 6 hours @21C. For optimum hold-out allow to dry overnight, then sand, before applying topcoat.

The use of 178B/570BS will extend recoating times to overnight cure.

Theoretical Coverage

Approximately 8 sq. m/litre @ 50µm DFT (catalysed).

Practical coverage rates will be lower than theoretical and this must be taken into consideration when calculating costs.

Safety Precautions

Read each component's material safety data sheet before use. Mixed material has hazards of each component. Safety precautions must be strictly followed during storage, handling and use.
